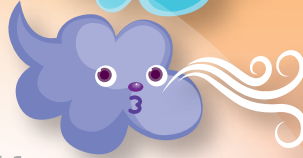



### Chapter 3: Understanding Articulation in Music

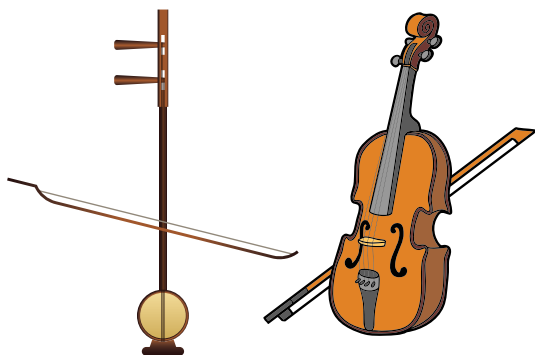
Articulation in music refers to how specific notes are played. There are many types of articulation. In this concert, we will learn the Staccato, Legato, Arco, Pizzicato, Tremolo and Glissando.

<b>Staccato</b>		To play the note short and separated
<b>Legato</b>		To play in a smooth manner
<b>Arco</b>		To bow a string
<b>Pizzicato</b>		To pluck a string
<b>Tremolo</b>		To rapidly repeat a single note
<b>Glissando</b>		To slide from one note to another
